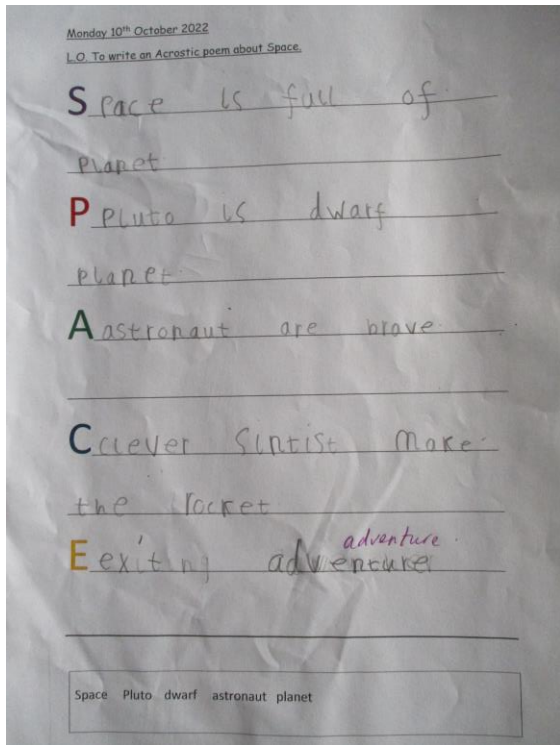
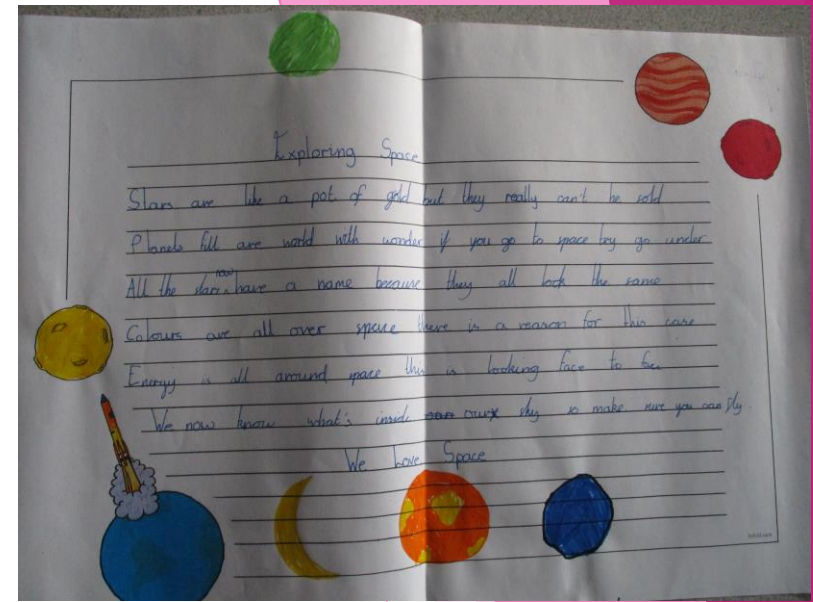
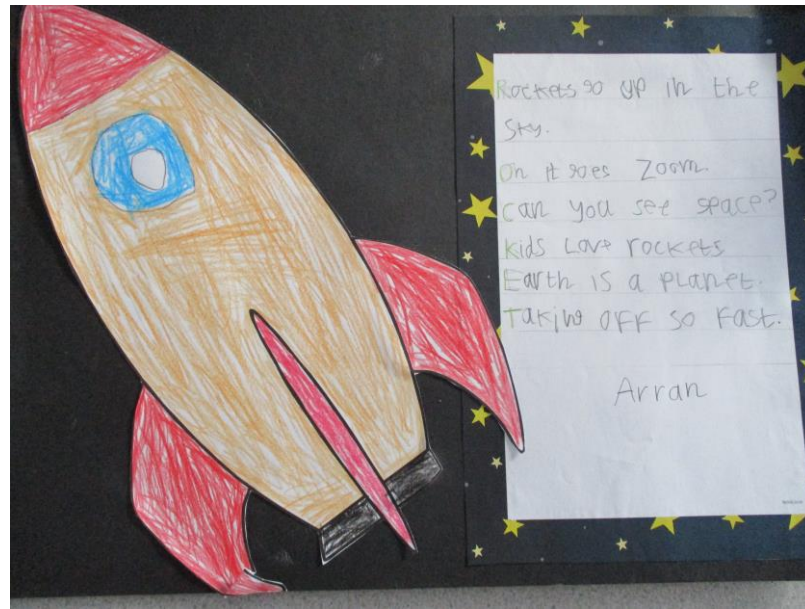
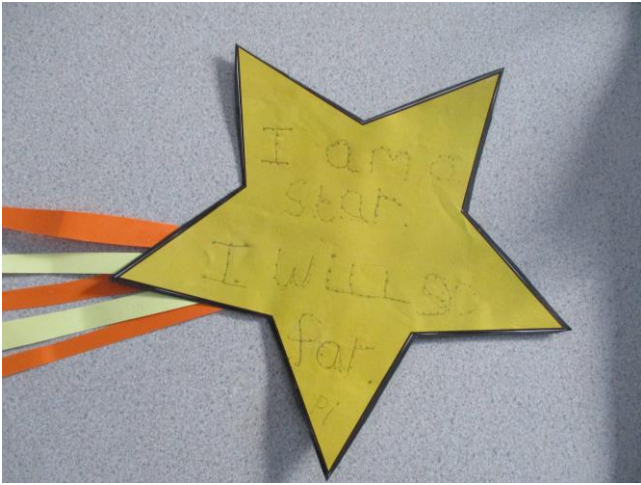


What an amazing competition.

Science Consortium, so thank you everybody.

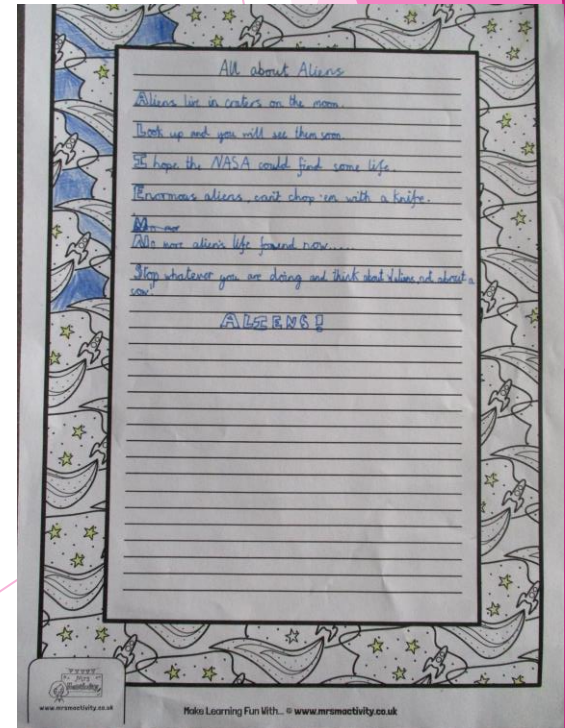


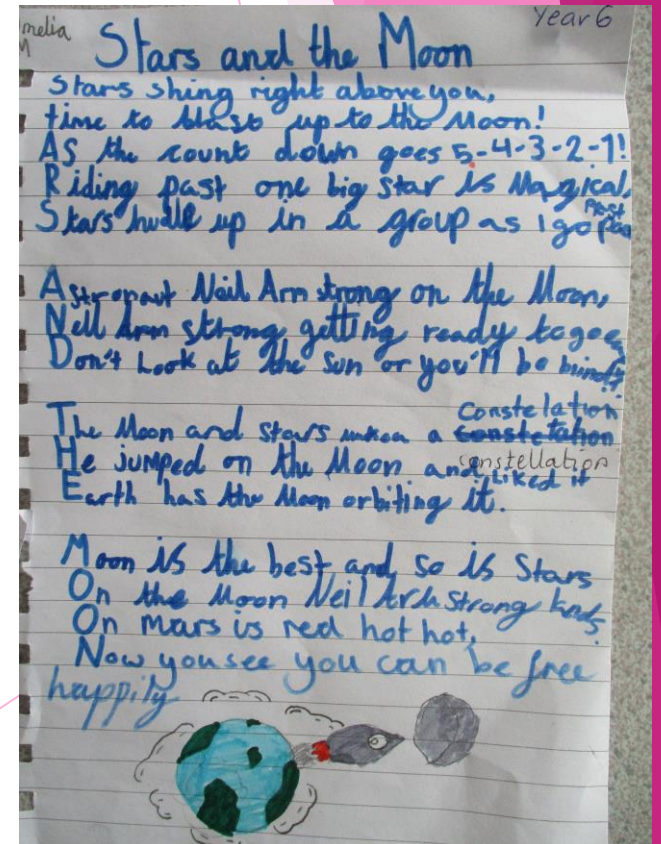
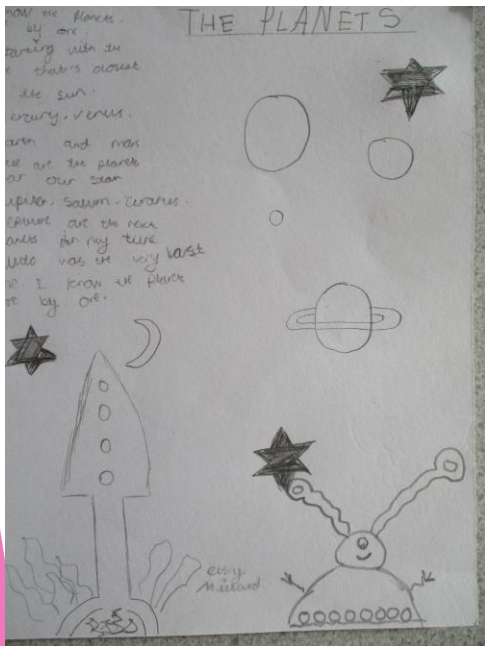
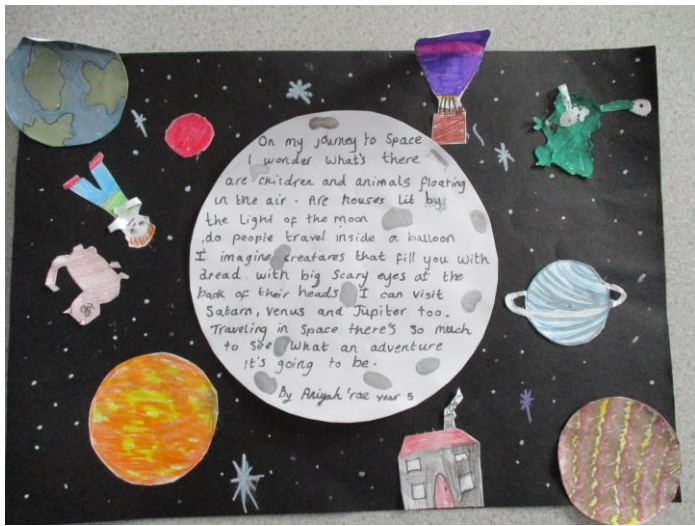
We had entries from every class.

Thankfully, I did not have to judge them.

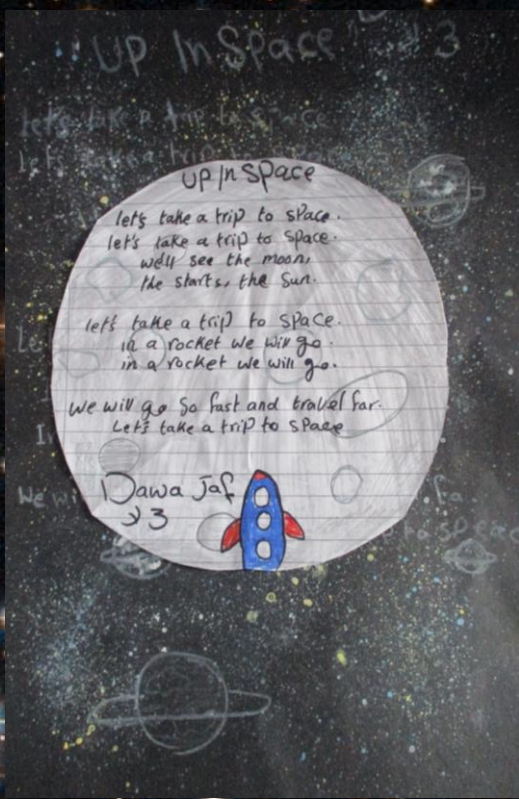
